School Uniform Policy

The school has a uniform as we feel it gives the children a sense of belonging and pride. We like our children to be clean and tidy at all times.

Light grey sweatshirts or sweatcardis embroidered with the school logo are worn. Plain grey is also acceptable. These are ordered online at www.touchline-embroidery.net in ages 3/4 to 13/14. Under the sweatshirt a green polo T-shirt is worn. These are also ordered from Touchline. The children can wear grey trousers, grey skirts, or pinafore dresses. Trousers must be of smart appearance and of a recognised school style. Any shade of grey is acceptable.

In the Summer many children choose to wear shorts or a green and white checked Summer dress. Children can either wear the school sweatshirt or a school sweatcardi. Alternative cardigans are not permitted.

Socks should be grey, black or white, and tights are to be grey or green. Black shoes are to be worn. Trainers and boots are not permitted.

We have a school fleece, reversible waterproof coat, bobble hat and cap all of which are available from Touchline but are not compulsory uniform items.

For PE in warm weather, all children should wear plain navy or black shorts or leggings, of a regular PE style, and a T-shirt embroidered with the school logo. Plain pale blue is also acceptable. The T-shirts are ordered from Touchline and are available in sizes 22" to 36". Pumps or trainers are to be worn.

For cold weather PE sessions, a plain dark blue or black track suit can be worn, together with the blue school PE T-shirt and trainers. Jogging pants and plain blue or black sweatshirts are also acceptable. We ask that PE kits are not multi-coloured so that all the children are dressed in a similar way throughout the school day. Children are asked to come to school wearing their PE kit on the days their class has a PE lesson.

Plain ear studs and watches may be worn. No other jewellery is permitted. The school cannot accept responsibility for any lost or damaged items. Jewellery must be removed or covered for PE and games for Health and Safety reasons. Make-up, nail varnish and false nails are not permitted. Mobile 'phones must not be brought into school. Hair accessories should be in either school or neutral colours. Tramlines cut into the hair are not permitted.

Being a small school with limited space, it is essential that large bags are not brought to school. We have our own school book-bag for KS1 or a backpack for KS2. Again these are available from Touchline. Please note that these are compulsory items and alternative bags are not permitted.
